Jersey Cricket believes that children benefit from coaches and parents working together in partnership. We recognise parents as the child's first and most important educator and aim to involve them in all aspects of the life in cricket. In order to achieve a strong working partnership with parents:

The parent or main carer will be fully involved during the signing in process.

If we have any concern about a child's wellbeing during the day every effort will be made to contact the parents or their emergency contact.

Parents are requested to keep us informed of any changes to personal circumstances which may have an effect upon their child e.g. change of address, telephone number, doctor, emergency contact and a change of parent/guardian pick up.

Parents are also requested to keep us informed of any circumstances that could influence a child's emotional wellbeing, e.g. bereavement, separation or illness in the family.

The coaches are always available to talk to parents. It is much easier to discuss and sort out any small problems before they become big ones.
